

Build Your Own MCG

Activity

Build your own scale model of the MCG as it looks during the present day. Include the main features like the Great Southern Stand, the Members Pavilion, other grandstands, goal posts or the cricket pitch, the boundary fence, the scoreboards, the big screens and the light towers.

Other Models: The Past

Your MCG can be from a different era. Find out what the MCG looked like during the 1956 Olympic Games. Recreate the athletics track and the old grandstands. Include the cauldron and the flags of some of the competing nations.

Other Models: The Future

Your MCG can be a futuristic design representing the MCG in the 21st century. You might include an all weather surface and a retractable roof. What other features might you add to your model?

Suggested Scale

The playing surface is about 175m long and about 150m wide. Reduce the scale to one of the following:

- 1:1000 then your oval will need to be 17.5cm long
- 1:500 then your oval will need to be 35cm long
- 1:200 then your oval will need to be 75cm long

Alternatively, create your own scale.
