The Lead-up

This is the sixth and last of the group matches at the Super 12 stage of the tournament to be played at the MCG leading up to the finals. The group matches are:

England v Ireland	Wednesday, 26 October, 2022	3.00 pm

The semi-finals will be played in Sydney at the SCG on Wednesday, 9 November 2022 and in Adelaide on Thursday, 10 November 2022 with the final being played at the MCG on Sunday, 13 November, 2022.

India automatically qualified for the 2022 tournament as a result of playing at the Super 12 stage of the 2021 tournament and its ICC ranking at 15 November, 2021. Zimbabwe qualified as a result of winning the First Round Group B of this tournament.

The two Countries in the ICC Men's T20 World Cup to date

India has participated in all tournaments to date; reaching the final rounds (Groups E and F in 2007 and 2009 and Super 8s, 10s or 12s in succeeding tournaments) on each occasion. India has made the semi-finals on three occasions; winning once (2007) and being runner-up once (2014). Zimbabwe has participated in five of the tournaments played to date: 2007, 2010, 2012, 2014 and 2016. It has, however, not progressed beyond the initial group stage. Zimbabwe did not compete in the 2009 and 2021 tournaments.

The two countries have not yet met in an ICCMT20WC match. Away from the World Cup they have met on seven occasions in T20Is. All of the matches have been played in Zimbabwe's capital Harare, the first being in 2010 and the most recent in 2016. Summary scores from that match are:

At Harare, Sports Club, June 22, 2016: **INDIA 6/138** (20 overs) (KM Jadhav 58*; DT Tripano 3/20), **defeated ZIMBABWE 6/135** (20 overs) (DS Kulkani 2/23, B Sran 2/31) by three runs. *Player of the Match:* KM Jadhav (India).

In all T20Is India has played 174 matches for 111 wins, 33 losses, three ties and five have yielded a no result. Zimbabwe has played 112 matches for 33 wins. 77 losses and two have been tied.
