Shane Warne vs South Africa in Test cricket

A glance at our companion "Australia v South Africa Statistical Supplement" for the Boxing Day Test reveals an enormous lead at the top of the "Career Wickets" table for SK Warne as the leading wicket taker with 130. Warne is followed by CV Grimmett on 77 and DW Styne on 70. As a tribute to the late, great, Shane Warne on the first day of Test cricket at the MCG since his death, we would like to dedicate today's Fact Sheet to his 130 Test wickets against South Africa.

Shane Warne's first South African Test wicket was WJ Cronje, caught by DC Boon for 71 in the first innings of the drawn 1993 Boxing Day Test. Mark Waugh and Craig McDermott took the only two other South African wickets in the badly rain affected match. Warne made up for it in the next Test, the New Year match at the SCG. He took 7/56 and 5/72 in Australia's five run loss. It was his first 10+ wicket haul in a match, and the 7/56 would be his most wickets in an innings haul against South Africa.

Overall Warne took seven five+ wickets in an inning seven times in his 24 Tests against South Africa. Four of these were at the SCG, and one each at Adelaide, Cape Town and Kingsmead. He took 10+ wickets in a match against South Africa twice, both at the SCG, in the 1994 and 1998 New Year Tests.

Thanks to Eddie Perfect's *Shane Warne the Musical*, we think of Darryl Cullinan as Warne's "Bunny in the Headlights". In actual fact, Warne only dismissed Cullinan in four Test innings. Of his other South African victims, Warne dismissed Hansie Cronje and David Richardson eight times, Mark Boucher and Herschelle Gibbs seven times, Jacques Kallis, Brian McMillan, Makhaya Ntini and Shaun Pollock six times, and Gary Kirsten five times. However Warne's real South African bunny was Ashwell Prince, who was out to Warne in eight consecutive Test innings (a Test record), and 11 times in total.

For the eight consecutive Test dismissals, Warne started by having Prince caught by RT Ponting for 20 in Cape Town on March 11, 2022. He was then caught for a duck by B Lee, and caught ME Waugh for 48 at Durban on March 16 & 18, 2002. In Perth in December 2005, Warne dismissed Prince LBW in both innings – for 28 on the 17th, and for 8 on the 20th. At the 2005 Boxing Day Test Warne had Prince caught by RT Ponting for 6 on December 28, and caught by ML Hayden for 26 on December 30. Finally at the SCG on January 3, 2006, Warne trapped Prince LBW when he was on 119. The run was broken in the 2nd innings when Prince was caught on 18 by RT Ponting off the bowling of SCG MacGill.


Our memorial tribute booklet to Rod Marsh and Shane Warne is available from the MCC Library reference desk during the 2022 Boxing Day Test.

Test Cricket at the MCG

Beginning with the inaugural Test match in March 1877, 114 Tests have been staged at the MCG. South Africa has been involved in 12 of the Tests played here. Australia has won 7 of these contests and South Africa 3, with the other two drawn.

Other sides to play Tests at the MCG are England (57) the West Indies (15), India (14), Pakistan (10), New Zealand (4) and Sri Lanka (2). One Test, scheduled against England in 1970/71, was abandoned without a ball bowled and is not counted in the records.

Boxing Day Tests at the MCG

Traditionally, the Victoria versus New South Wales Sheffield Shield clash was played at the MCG over Christmas, and prior to the 1968/69 season, only two MCG Tests had included play on Boxing Day: the 2nd Test against England in 1950/51, which began on Friday December 22 (Boxing Day, a Tuesday, being the third day of the match), and the 2nd Test against South Africa in 1952/53, which commenced on Christmas Eve.

The first Test to <u>begin</u> on Boxing Day at the MCG was the 2nd Test against the West Indies in 1968/69, the 56th at the ground, when bleak conditions restricted the attendance to 18,786. During the following decade only two MCG Tests featured play on December 26: the 2nd Test against England in 1974/75, and the 2nd Test against the West Indies the following season, both of which commenced on that day.

Since 1980/81, only one season has not featured Test cricket at the MCG on Boxing Day. This was in 1989/90 when, owing to the late arrival of the Pakistan team, a One-Day International against Sri Lanka was played instead, the MCG Test involving Pakistan being put back to mid-January.

MCG Tests have begun on Boxing Day in each of the other seasons during this period, apart from 1984/85, when the 4th Test against the West Indies started on December 22 and in 1988/89 and 1994/95, when matches against the West Indies and England both commenced on Christmas Eve.
