AUSTRALIA V SOUTH AFRICA DAY 1 LIBRARY STATISTICAL SUPPLEMENT

During the period 15 to 19 March 1877 a match played between an Australian eleven and Lillywhite's English Team on the MCG was subsequently recognised as the first Test. South Africa played its first Test against England at Port Elizabeth (now known as Ggeberha) in March 1889.
