

# YOUR GUIDE TO THE BCNA FIELD OF WOMEN

We look forward to welcoming you to the MCG for the BCNA Field of Women event, prior to the Pink Lady Match between Melbourne and Hawthorn.

Please read the information below carefully to ensure you are ready for the Field of Women event.

Allow plenty of time for registration and pack collection. Plan to arrive early to the MCG and plan your journey accordingly. If you arrive late, you may not be able to participate in the Field of Women event.

## **Event schedule**

**10.30am:** Ticket box office and pack collection opens. Yarra Park Family Festival commences.

- 12.00pm: Gates open for Field of Women participants.
- 12.45pm: Field of Women commences.
- **1.00pm:** Public gates open for the BCNA Pink Lady Match.
- **1.45pm:** Field of Women ends. Participants exit the arena and to their seating area. **3.20pm:** Melbourne v Hawthorn match commences.

## Accessing the Field of Women

#### Public patrons

Your Field of Women tickets have been sent to your nominated email address or mobile phone number from Ticketek. You can view your order confirmation in your Order History tab on the Ticketek website. Prior to entering the stadium for the Field of Women event, you will need to present your Field of Women ticket to collect your gift pack. The gift pack collection and registration zones are located:

- On the lawn near Gate 1 (city end)
- On the lawn between Gates 5 and 6 (Richmond Station end)

Once you have collected your pack, you can enter the MCG from 12.00pm via Gates 1, 5, 6 or 7.

#### MCC members, AFL members and Club members

Prior to entering the stadium for the Field of Women event, members who have purchased a Field of Women upgrade ticket must collect their pre-purchased tickets and Field of Women gift packs from the Ticketek Box Office at Gate 3B.

The Ticketek Box Office will be open from 10.30am on Sunday.

After receiving your ticket and pack from the Ticketek Box Office, please proceed to your relevant Gate for entry. Gates open for Field of Women participants from 12.00pm.

- MCC members: Gate 2B
- AFL members: Gate 6 or 7
- Club members: Gate 1 or 5

## **Merchandise collection**

If you have purchased BCNA merchandise, present your order confirmation at the marquee opposite Gate 3 to pick up your goods.

## What to bring

- Only bring what you need. To increase the efficiency of your entry to the stadium and your Field of Women experience, we recommend not bringing a bag where possible.
- Should it rain, umbrellas are not permitted to be open inside the venue. Your poncho has a hood and will keep you dry if it rains.
- Prams are not permitted on the MCG arena. Storage is available at the Customer Service Office located on Level B1 at Gate 1.
- Wear warm clothing and flat, comfortable shoes. No high heels will be allowed on the Ground.

## Accessible entry requirements

The accessible entry point for the Field of Women is via Gate 1, meeting at the back of M35. Volunteers in yellow vests will be able to assist you and help you make your way onto the Ground.

Arrangements can be made with VicDeaf for an interpreter during the event. Should you require this assistance, please contact BCNA via <u>fieldofwomen@bcna.org.au</u>.
